



## HURRICANE HARVEY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

*\$493 million was raised by the American Red Cross for Hurricane Harvey Disaster Relief*

Homeowners and Renters may be eligible if your primary place of residence was destroyed or suffered major damage as a result of Hurricane Harvey. (Major damage means more than \$17,000 in verified damages.)

**\$1600 in financial assistance from the American Red Cross may be available to those who are eligible**

### Homeowners

- FEMA award letter or Certified Inspection Report from your Homeowner's Insurance Company/NFIP policy.
- Copy of current photo ID or Driver's License.
- Proof of ownership at the time of the disaster (Dated between: July 25, 2017-August 25, 2017) ie: copy of the deed or mortgage for the damaged residence.
- Substantial Damage Letter from Montgomery County Engineer's Office, if applicable.
- Proof of residency at the time of the disaster (Dated between: July 25-August 25, 2017) ie: copy of a utility bill or bank statement.

### Renters

- Copy of lease or rental agreement valid July 25, 2017-August 25, 2017.
- FEMA award letter or insurance.
- Copy of current photo ID or Driver's License.
- Proof of residency at the time of the disaster (Dated between: July 25-August 25, 2017) ie: copy of a utility bill or bank statement.

**Residents must show proof of major damage of \$17,000 or more.**



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
